Amova E Fund ChiNext Index ETF

The investment objective of the Fund is to track as closely as possible, before fees and expenses, the returns of the ChiNext Total Return Index ("ChiNext Index").

The Fund is a feeder fund and seeks to achieve the above by investing all or substantially all of its Net Asset Value into the E Fund ChiNext ETF (the "Underlying Fund"). The Fund will be offered in both RMB share class and SGD-Hedged share class, with the latter offering a solution that strives to minimise impact of foreign currency fluctuations between the SGD and RMB. E Fund's ChiNext ETF is the largest ChiNext ETF available with Assets Under Management (AUM) of approximately USD 15 billion as at end Mar 2025.

What is ChiNext board?

The ChiNext board of the Shenzhen Stock Exchange (SZSE) is set up to provide a platform for growth-oriented, innovative, and entrepreneurial enterprises. The ChiNext board is often seen as the 'NASDAQ-style' board of the SZSE.

As of 31 March 2025, there are close to 1,400 companies listed on the ChiNext board, with a stock market capitalisation of approximately SGD 2.4 trillion.

The ChiNext Index consists of the top 100 largest and most liquid A-share stocks listed on the ChiNext board of SZSE, weighted by free float market capitalisation.

3. Gateway to untapped opportunities

The ChiNext Index provides investors access to companies that may be still under the radar of global investors. These underexplored markets allow for an early-mover advantage into China's innovation economy with lower exposure to State-owned enterprises.

China is a well known for being a global leader with a track record in Innovation. From 2014 to 2023, China accounted for 70% of patent applications related to generative Artificial Intelligence (AI), ranking itself as first in the world. In the recent 2 years, China has led with the most number of Science & Technology innovation clusters globally, with the US trailing in 2nd place.

Offered in SGD-Hedged share class

The ETF offers an SGD-Hedged share class, applying a currency hedge of SGD against the RMB. As the Underlying Fund and its constituents are in RMB, the currency hedge layer applied to this share class will help to minimise foreign currency exchange rate fluctuations, a valuable feature for investors that prefer less volatility due to currency moves.
